

## CERTIFICATE OF ACHIEVEMENT

# Orthopedic Technician Program

This program of study will provide students with in-depth knowledge and skills necessary to work as an orthopedic technician. Skills include immobilization, traction, casting, splinting, and assisting physicians with orthopedic care. The program of study requires all applicants to complete BIOL 125 with a grade of "C" or better, and passing of the reading and math assessment tests scoring above READ 043 and ENGL 035 prior to application. Following acceptance into the Orthopedic Technician program, the students will complete four core orthopedic courses. In total the program of study is 19 units. Upon completion of the program, students will receive a Certificate of Achievement and be eligible to take national certification through the National Board of Certified Orthopedic Technicians (NBCOT).
