The Associate of Arts degree in Social Work provides a foundation for students interested in the fields of social work, human services, counseling and related areas. The curriculum is designed to meet lower-division transfer courses for many CSU's with majors in Social Work, Sociology with an emphasis in Social Work or Human Services. The degree also offers a basis for students interested in paraprofessional jobs in the human services field.
