# BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

## ASSOCIATE OF ARTS DEGREE

This is a degree which allows students to fulfill lower division pre-business requirements for the California State University System. Students should work closely with counselors to select the appropriate math course and other lower division courses which are required by the four-year college of their choice.

To acquire the **Associate of Arts Degree in Business Administration**, students must complete the required major courses below with a grade of "C" or better or of "P" if the course was taken on a Pass/No Pass basis, along with either of the following: Rio Hondo College General Education (RHC GE) or California General Education Transfer Curriculum (Cal-GETC). California State University General Education-Breadth (CSU GE) or Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) may be used in some cases; please see a counselor for details.

NOTE: Students interested in transferring as Business Administration majors should consult with a counselor for appropriate general education & major preparation counseling.
