The Associate of Arts Degree in Music is a two-year program designed to prepare students for the continued study of music and/or future professional employment in the field of music. Graduates receive an Associate of Arts degree in Music. Students entering the program with the intent to perform will gain valuable experience and performance skills performing in our various choirs and our unique multi-instrumental ensemble. The various levels of study in vocal, instrumental, theory, musicianship, and keyboard skills will supply students with the necessary abilities to excel in those areas when they complete the music program at Rio Hondo College.

To acquire the **Associate of Arts Degree in Music**, students must complete the required major courses below with a grade of "C" or better along with one of the following:
