The Certificate, approved by the Chancellor's Office, indicates a student's successful acquisition of essential English language skills necessary for short conversations and for reading/writing at the sentence level.

To acquire the **Noncredit Certificate of Competency in Foundational English as a Second Language**, student must complete the required courses below with a grade of "P" for passing:
