The Public Safety Officer noncredit program provides a platform for students interested in the field of Public Safety. It provides guidance in navigating the diverse careers in this ever-expanding field. The instructors are highly qualified and knowledgeable in the subject areas. The goals of the program include raising the PELLETB passing rate, reinforce developing balanced study habits, personal nutrition, academic preparation, and to orient students on specific skills necessary for entry-level positions in law enforcement. This program also serves as a bridge to Rio Hondo College Police Academy.

The public safety officer courses are organized in a way to earn the Certificate of Completion Public Safety I, and Certificate of Completion Public Safety Officer II
