PSYCHIATRIC TECHNICIAN TO RN ASSOCIATE DEGREE NURSING

The Associate degree Nursing Program is a two-year program designed to prepare students for employment as a Registered Nurse, providing direct care to patients. Graduates receive an **Associates of Science Degree in Nursing**. The program is approved by the California State Board of Registered Nursing. Students who complete the curriculum are qualified to take the examination leading to licensure as a Registered Nurse. Current California psychiatric technician license required. To acquire the Associate of Science Degree in Nursing, students must complete one of the following: Río Hondo College General Education and Proficiency requirements, California State University General Education Breadth (CSU GE), or Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC).
