# SOCIAL WORK AND HUMAN SERVICES FOR TRANSFER

## ASSOCIATE IN ARTS DEGREE

The Associate in Arts in Social Work and Human Services for Transfer (AA-T) Degree provides a foundation for students interested in the fields of social work, human services, counseling and related areas. The curriculum is designed to meet lower-division major requirements for the social work and human services (or similar) major at a CSU, including collaborative health and human services, criminal justice, human services, social work, and sociology. In addition to the courses listed below, the following additional requirements must be met for completion of the Associate in Arts in Social Work and Human Services for Transfer Degree:

1. Completion of a minimum of 60 CSU-transferable semester units.
2. Achievement of a minimum GPA of at least 2.0 in all CSU-transferable coursework (some majors may require a higher GPA; students should consult with a counselor for more information).
3. Completion of the major with a grade of "C" or better in each course or a "P" if the course was taken on a Pass/No Pass basis and the "P" is equal to a "C" or better.
4. Certified completion of the California State University General Education-Breadth (CSU GE) pattern; OR the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) pattern.

NOTE: Students are advised to check with the Counseling Department or Transfer Center for the courses accepted into the Social Work and Human Services (or similar) major at the CSU where they seek transfer.
