The Mat Pilates Instructor Certificate of Achievement is designed to prepare students for employment as a professional to instruct both groups and individuals in Pilates mat exercises. The program will also expose students to other areas such as fitness, health promotion, coaching, pre-allied health, and medical fields as Pilates is often used in physical therapy rehabilitation, injury prevention, and enhancing the performance of athletes.
