ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE DEGREE

The following curriculum meets the requirement for an Associate of Science Degree in Drug Studies. The Drug Studies Program is accredited by the California Association of Alcohol and Drug Educators (CAADE). The courses needed for the degree are designed for those who wish to transfer to a four-year institution and pursue a Bachelor's Degree in Human Services or other discipline that serves as preparation for a career in the helping professions.

To acquire an **Associate of Science Degree in Drug Studies**, students must complete the required major courses below with a grade of "C" or better or of "P" if the course was taken on a Pass/No Pass basis, along with either of the following: Rio Hondo College General Education (RHC GE) or California General Education Transfer Curriculum (Cal-GETC). California State University General Education - Breadth (CSU GE) or Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) may be used in some cases; please see a counselor for details.
