# PHOTOGRAPHY

ASSOCIATE OF ARTS DEGREE

The Associate of Arts in Photography provides students with a foundational knowledge of important conceptual and technical aspects of fine art photography with the goal of preparing students to transfer to a four-year university. The courses in this degree emphasize photography as a means of communication and personal expression, with an emphasis on cultural significance and visual literacy. Students planning to prepare for a four-year degree in photography should consult the lower division requirements of the university to which they plan to transfer.

To acquire the **Associate of Arts Degree in Photography**, students must complete the required major courses below with a grade of "C" or better along with one of the following:

- RHC GE and Proficiency requirements
- CSU GE (California State University General Education Breadth)
- IGETC (Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum)
