Cal-GETC Considerations

- Students who start at a California Community College in Fall 2025 or later and want to complete a transfer GE pattern will follow Cal-GETC. Students who started prior to Fall 2025 may follow Cal-GETC, CSU GE, or IGETC; for questions about these options, please meet with a counselor.
- Each UC campus has its own guidelines for the Languages other than English requirement. Please see https://admission.universityofcalifornia.edu/counselors/uc-graduation-requirements/ for more details.
- Students with substantial coursework from institutions outside of the United States should consult with a counselor to determine whether they should complete Cal-GETC or the lower-division breadth/general education requirements at the campus they plan to attend.
- All coursework used for Cal-GETC must be completed with a "C" or better, and each course must have a minimum value of 3 semester/4 quarter units.
- Cal-GETC may not be appropriate for all majors. It is <u>highly recommended</u> that students meet with a counselor and/or consult with individual campuses prior to selecting courses.
- A course may be counted for one GE area only.
