ASSOCIATE IN ARTS FOR TRANSFER DEGREE

The Associate in Arts in Global Studies for Transfer (AA-T) degree provides students with a multidisciplinary foundation for understanding global issues, systems, and cultures. This program is designed to prepare students for upper-division coursework in global studies or related fields such as international relations, political science, environmental studies, and economics at a California State University (CSU). The Global Studies AA-T equips students with the analytical tools to assess the political, social, economic, and environmental challenges facing the world today. Emphasis is placed on the study of globalization, international conflicts, human rights, environmental sustainability, global health, economic development, and the role of international organizations.

In addition to the courses listed below, the following requirements must be met for completion of the **Associate in Arts in Global Studies for Transfer Degree**: 1. Completion of 60 CSU-transferable semester units. 2. Achievement of a minimum GPA of at least 2.0 in all CSU-transferable coursework. (Some majors may require a higher GPA; please see a counselor for details.) 3. Completion of each major course with a grade of "C" or better or a "P" if the course was taken on a Pass/No Pass basis and the "P" is equal to a "C" or better. 4. Completion of the California General Education Transfer Curriculum (Cal-GETC). The California State University General Education Breadth (CSU GE) or Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) may be used in some cases; please see a counselor for details.
